University/Tertiary Studies up to an amount of \$2,000

Any funding approved by the RC Committee will be directed to the provider or supplier only.

1. EDUCATION SUPPORT

The RNO Relationship Committee acknowledges that education support for our Wagyl Kaip/Southern Noongar Agreement group is essential to our growth as a community; therefore, the FQM RC will support educational programs and initiatives.

1.1 Primary Education

a) Funding may be provided to individuals to assist with school booklist up to the value of \$150 for Primary and up to \$200 for Secondary per student. Funding approved by the RC Committee will be directed to the education provider or supplier.

b) **Application close: Quarterly**

First Friday in December.

Applications **must** include the following supporting documentation:

- Copy of quote from supplier/provider
- Bank Details of Supplier/ Provider. No reimbursement will be accepted.

1.2 WKSN TAFE VET / TRAINING

a) Subject to funding, grants may be available to individuals enrolled in Vocational Education of an amount up to \$750 for Certificate II and Certificate III qualifications and up to \$1,000 for Certificate IV qualification.

b) As per the funding guidelines, **evidence including proof of enrolment** must be provided.

1.3 WKSN Tertiary/University

a) Subject to funding, grants of up to \$2000 may be available to individuals enrolled in a Bachelor or higher-level tertiary degree at any University.

b) The WKSN Tertiary/university Scholarship is available to four students per year for up to an amount of \$3000 per course of study.

c) As per the funding guidelines, evidence including proof of enrolment and continuation of study must be provided. Students will be selected based on their applications which will outline their (a) academic achievements; (b) personal aspirations (present and future); and how the qualification will be beneficial to the Noongar community.

d) Applications close: Quarterly.

Applications **must** include the following supporting documentation:

- Evidence of enrolment
- Summary of (a) academic achievements; (b) personal aspirations (present and future); and how the qualification will be beneficial to the Noongar community.

2. COMMUNITY SUPPORT: Subject to funding grants may be provided to applicants. The RNO Relationship Committee acknowledges that community initiatives are important for the maintenance, survival and enhancement of our culture and that Noongar community development is important to underpin improvements across education, health, and well-being.

a) Funding may be provided to assist with activities such as NAIDOC Week, Noongar community gardens and creation of information sources for public viewing. Grant application up to maximum value of \$5,000. All approved funding must be acquitted.

Community/ Organisation Applications **must** also include Grant Application (2 application) and the following supporting documentation is required:

- Quotes
- Detailed budget
- Other funding sources
- Bank Details

3. HEALTH AND WELLBEING

The RNO Relationship Committee acknowledges that health and well-being initiatives are fundamental to the healthy lifestyle of our Noongar community.

a) Funding will be provided to individuals for up to \$2,000 that may include dental work and medical equipment.

b) Prescription glasses and contact lenses will be subject to a maximum limit of \$200.

c) A maximum amount of \$2000 may be provided towards the purchase of a gopher. Successful applicants will become the asset owner and responsible for ongoing repairs and maintenance.

Applications **must** include the following supporting documentation:

- Medical Support letters must include a statement of relevant medical need and confirm that the operator can use the gopher safely.

Funding will not be guaranteed for future years and payments to international bank accounts will not be accepted.
